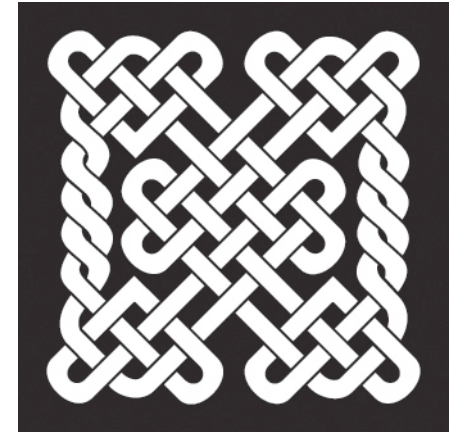

Eligibility: (please read carefully)

- Open to all artists living in Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Alaska, British Columbia, or Alberta.
- All formats of fiber art will be considered, including wall-hung, free-standing, or pedestal mounted. Entries must be original and must not be copied, derivatives, or based on other copyrighted or published work.
- Please include the dimensions and weight of your work with each entry.
- Maximum of three entries per artist.

Selection Conditions

- Requirements of Artwork Images Files - Dimensions: 1950 pixels horizontal x 1950 pixels vertical - File Format: JPG
File Name: JPG file names should include the correct file name extension, example: `artistnameartwork1.jpg`
- Please include in the email entry the following information: Artist's Name, Address, Email, Website, Title, Date of work, Height, Width, Depth, Weight, Medium, wall hung or free standing, Sale price/NFS, Narrative Description of Artwork (100 words or less for each entry.) and a brief Artist Statement (100 words or less.)
- Entries will be juried from projected digital files.
- Work must not exceed 50 inches x 50 inches and be ready to hang. Work that exceeds 50 pounds must be delivered and installed by the artist.
- Work with glass must be hand delivered. Work with plexiglass may be shipped.
- Museum & Arts Center reserves the right to refuse any work that does not match the sent jpeg image.
- Include a SASE for return of entry form and notification letter.

Accepted Works

- Works can be hand delivered or shipped. Delivery and shipping instructions will be emailed and with the notification letter.
- Artists are responsible for all shipping and handling costs to and from the exhibition.
- Each shipped entry must be packaged in a reusable container for the return of work.
- Return shipping must have pre-paid shipping labels.
- USP or USPS return shipping preferred.
- Unsold shipped entries will be returned at the close of exhibit.

Liability, Sales, and Promotion

- Museum and Arts Center is liable for work while on display in the museum during the exhibition dates.
- Artists may not substitute another work for an accepted work, alter the work or the sales price, nor withdraw the work after it has been accepted.
- Unless specified NFS, it is assumed that all work is for sale. A price list will be made available.
- Museum & Arts Center reserves the right to photograph entries for the purposes of documentation, education and publicity.
- Artists are encouraged to attend reception and be part of the festival.
